

**DRUG TESTING POLICY STATEMENT
AS PERTAINING
TO SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS**

The Plainfield Public School District is committed to the establishment of a drug use and alcohol misuse prevention program that meets all applicable requirements of the Omnibus Transportation Employee Testing Act of 1991 (OTETA) and applicable state statutes pertaining to pre-employment and random drug testing of school bus drivers. The District shall adhere to federal and state law and regulations requiring a school bus driver's drug and alcohol testing program.

Plainfield Public Schools endorse the DOT drug testing regulations and will comply with the regulations in their entirety. These regulations include:
