

Weighted Grading Policy

It is the policy of the Board of Education that a grade in a high school honors class or an advanced placement class is given added weight for purposes of calculating grade point average and determining class rank. The administration has developed and published a formula for calculation of grade point average and class rank reflecting the weighted grading system. The High School Principal shall ensure that parents are notified of this policy. It is currently described under “Ranking Procedures” in the Student Handbook.

“Advanced Placement Course Program” means a program approved by the state board of education that provides college or university level instruction as part of a course for which credit is earned at the high school level.
