

PLAINFIELD PUBLIC SCHOOLS
STUDENT FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES

Fund raising activities as previously approved by the Board of Education shall be allowed. (See Schedule A)

The administration shall have the responsibility to see that all fund raising activities are educationally sound, conducted in an orderly manner and that any money collected or disbursed is accounted for properly. Fund raising in the name of the Plainfield Schools or any school organizations or activities are subject to prior approval of the administration whether led by students, faculty, parents, or booster groups. Concessions at school events or on school property are to be maintained with the approval of and under the supervision of the administration.

All fund raising activities which involve outside "for profit" professional fund raising organizations must be submitted to the Board of Education for its approval, unless it is shown on Schedule A.
