INSTRUCTION OF STUDENTS AT HOME

REGULATIONS

I. ANNUAL REVIEW OF THE PORTFOLIO

The annual review of the home instruction includes an examination of the following:

- A. Samples of student work (assignments, tests, reports, projects, etc.)
- B. The instructional materials and methods person(s) responsible for home instruction supplementary material and other resources)

II. ADMITTANCE TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Re-admittance or initial registration in the public schools will include the following:

- A. A parent or guardian of a child who has been involved in home instruction must register the child in a public or private school if the program at home is terminated. If the student enrolls in the Plainfield Public Schools supportive documents will be reviewed by appropriate personnel to determine recommendations for grade level placement. Credits that a secondary school age pupil may wish to accumulate toward high school graduation will also be examined.
- B. Appropriate achievement tests or department examinations may be required prior to final determination for grade level placement or the awarding of high school credits. Neither diplomas nor certificates are authorized for students who are participating solely in home schooling. Students must enter the regular public school program and complete all the necessary requirements to be eligible for a Plainfield High School diploma.
